

Loma Linda Academy has a very helpful and easy-to-use parent portal that we call your "MyLLA" portal. Here are some instructions on how to access some of the many helpful resources that are available.

# Parent Access to the myLLA Portal

- 1. Visit <u>http://www.lla.org</u>
- 2. Click on the myLLA link on the top
- 3. Log in using your username and password. If you don't remember it, you can click on the "Forgot login or First time logging in?" link to change it.
- 4. **GENERAL PARENT RESOURCES:** Once you're logged in, you'll see a bunch of boxes that contain general resources that you'll find helpful. Among those links you can access Smart Tuition to pay for tuition, the monthly lunch menu, Information about volunteering, the handbook, parent calendar, Wednesday Word, and uniform store website, and more.



- 5. **CHILD-SPECIFIC INFO.:** To access child-specific information, look on the top left and you'll see the "Children" tab. If you only have one child enrolled, you'll just see his/her name. Click on that and select the child that you'd like to see information for.
- 6. This is where you'll see a summary of your child's grades, conduct, and attendance. Click on any of these for more details.
- 7. From this view, you can also access the following:
  - CLASS INFO.: To access your child's teacher's "Bulletin board", scroll down to the course lists and click on the course that says "Grade \_\_\_\_\_ Homeroom - <your child's teacher's

name>." Some teachers may also have a "**Topics**" tab that you can click on that will have more resources or information for you. NOTE: Since this is our first year using this myLLA portal, many teachers are still developing their Bulletin boards. If it's not visible yet, check back in a week or two for more information.



- 3. ROTATION TEACHER BULLETIN BOARDS: The courses that say "Computer Homeroom", "Library Homeroom", "Physical Education Homeroom," "Music Homeroom", "Campus Ministries," and "School Psychology" are general bulletin boards that you can access to view information about all 4 of our specialist rotations and additional services that your child has access to. Grades are not posted in these courses; they are just for informational purposes.
