Hi Parents:

This week we are completing our Spring MAP testing. We are taking our tests in the classroom from 9:0010:30 a.m. (Wed. and Thurs.) and 8:30-10:00 a.m. on Friday. Students do not need to prepare ahead of time for these tests.

Fourth quarter is flying by, and we are working on some projects in class. Students' will be presenting their Canada section 1 project this coming Monday. Time is given daily for the students to work on this project in class. This project must be typed and all students must include a hand drawn map of their province or territory and a hand drawn flag. Tomorrow, all $6^{\text {th }}$ grade students will be given a copy of the Ch. 6 post-course test to take home if they want to review $6^{\text {th }}$ grade concepts for their upcoming $7^{\text {th }}$ grade math placement test. Students will be taking this test on May 18. Students can also review these concepts on IXL, in their math textbook and/or on the Big Ideas website. Please note that there is nothing your child needs to do to prepare for the math placement test, but students who would like to do some review may use this handout to help them do so.
