Students will be taking their chapter 2 Math test tomorrow, November 16. We spent today's class period reviewing questions specifically from the two practice tests and two quizzes students completed throughout the chapter. Students are encouraged to look over their Ch. 2 online assignments one final time to prepare for the test.
