CLASSROOM NEWS:

CH. 1 MATH TEST—Students will have their **Ch. 1 math test Wednesday, September 28.** . Students have completed the end of the chapter review that includes extra review of all 5 lessons, an end of chapter quiz, two practice tests, and a cumulative practice test to help prepare for their final test. Students are encouraged to review the lessons we covered in class by looking through their math journals. They are also encouraged to review their online assignments. They can do this by logging into the Big Ideas website, <https://bigideasmath.com/BIM/login>. After they are logged in they can view all the assignments they have completed by clicking on “submitted.” Students can see what the correct answers are if they missed any questions. They can also watch videos to help them on questions they missed. There is also a section for students to practice skills that are used in this chapter. This website has a wealth of information!
